
Dedicated Semester 2011 Grant

Fontbonne University's dedicated semester is a unique academic program that encourages the university as a whole—students, faculty and staff—to explore a single theme each fall semester. The proposal, *The Disability Experience: Quest for Empowerment*, submitted by faculty members, Dr. Margaret Gray and Dr. Susan Lenihan, was chosen by the Dedicated Semester Committee as the theme for Fall 2011.

Eighteen months of careful planning produced a wide variety of specific events throughout the semester to complement the 17 courses within the university's curriculums that focused at least 25% of their course time on the disabilities theme. In noting the 20th anniversary of the passage of the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) legislation, Margaret and Susan designed their proposal to explore the challenges as well as celebrate the achievements of Americans with disabilities.

The limited University funding available to attract high profile speakers prompted the Committee to apply for a \$10,000 FCC grant to be specifically used for this purpose. As a result, three nationally recognized speakers came to Fontbonne, each participating in several presentations or activities during their time on campus:

Oct. 1—Jennifer Rosner, a parent of two deaf daughters and the author of *If A Tree Falls*, a memoir exploring "family, silence, and what it means to be heard"



(The book also led to a movie for the Hallmark Hall of Fame.)



Nov. 4—Brenda Smith Myles, PhD, award winning author of over 15 books on autism and Asperger's syndrome.

All three events attracted capacity attendance and produced over-whelmingly positive responses from all who were present.

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Prevention is Key



"This past spring semester, Maria Eftink, the Director of Athletics, along with Claudia Charles, the Director of Counseling and Wellness, four student athletes and two athletic staff members attended the Students (and Athletes) Thinking and Acting Responsibly and Safely (STARS) seminar. This NCAA conference took place in California where the participants formulated a solid plan for the Fontbonne campus for the future. The event taught student athletes how to work with their peers to deal with issues of drug use, stress, alcohol abuse and mental anguish and do so through peer-topeer mentoring, frequent random drug testing, and the implementation of other beneficial programs for the student athletes. The goal was to develop strong role models for Fontbonne and to instill the skills and education within the student athletes so that they can help themselves and others."


Fontbonne FCC DAY will be on August 29. Details are being arranged. Watch for more info.
