GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS

The annual Fontbonne Spring Horse Show consists of closed classes for the riders in the physical education departments of Fontbonne College and St. Joseph's Academy entered in various divisions leading to a grand championship. The open classes are offered to all riders and exhibitors of the area and add a welcome variety to the program.

In the closed classes, the riders are divided according to experience and ability. For this purpose, a beginner is a rider who has had no riding instruction or show experience prior to the beginning of the current school year. An advanced rider is one who has won a first or second place ribbon in any singles equitation class. All riders not included in either of the above divisions shall be classed as novice riders.

Contestants in equitation classes will be judged on hands and seat, general management and control of the horse. Only rental horses of the Missouri Stables, Inc., may be used, and these horses are drawn by lot by the contestants. Performance of the horse will not be considered except as an indication of the rider's ability to secure the required gaits in the best possible manner. Classes will enter the ring to the right and proceed in a counter-clockwise direction at least once around the ring at the walk, trot and canter, and on command, reverse and repeat. They shall then line up on command and execute individual tests at the judge's discretion.

The open classes in the various divisions will be judged in accordance with the rules of the American Horse Shows Association.

The Horse Show Committee reserves to itself the right to make any changes in the program it considers necessary for the improvement of the show, and the right to interpret all conditions and differences with regard thereto; and will be in full and absolute charge of all entries.

Fontbonne College and St. Joseph's Academy will not be responsible for any property damage, loss, or injury to spectators or participants in the show. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person whatsoever by any horse owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify The Fontbonne Horse Show Association against all claims or demands of any nature.

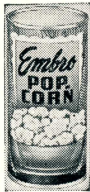

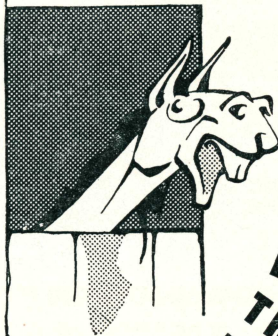
