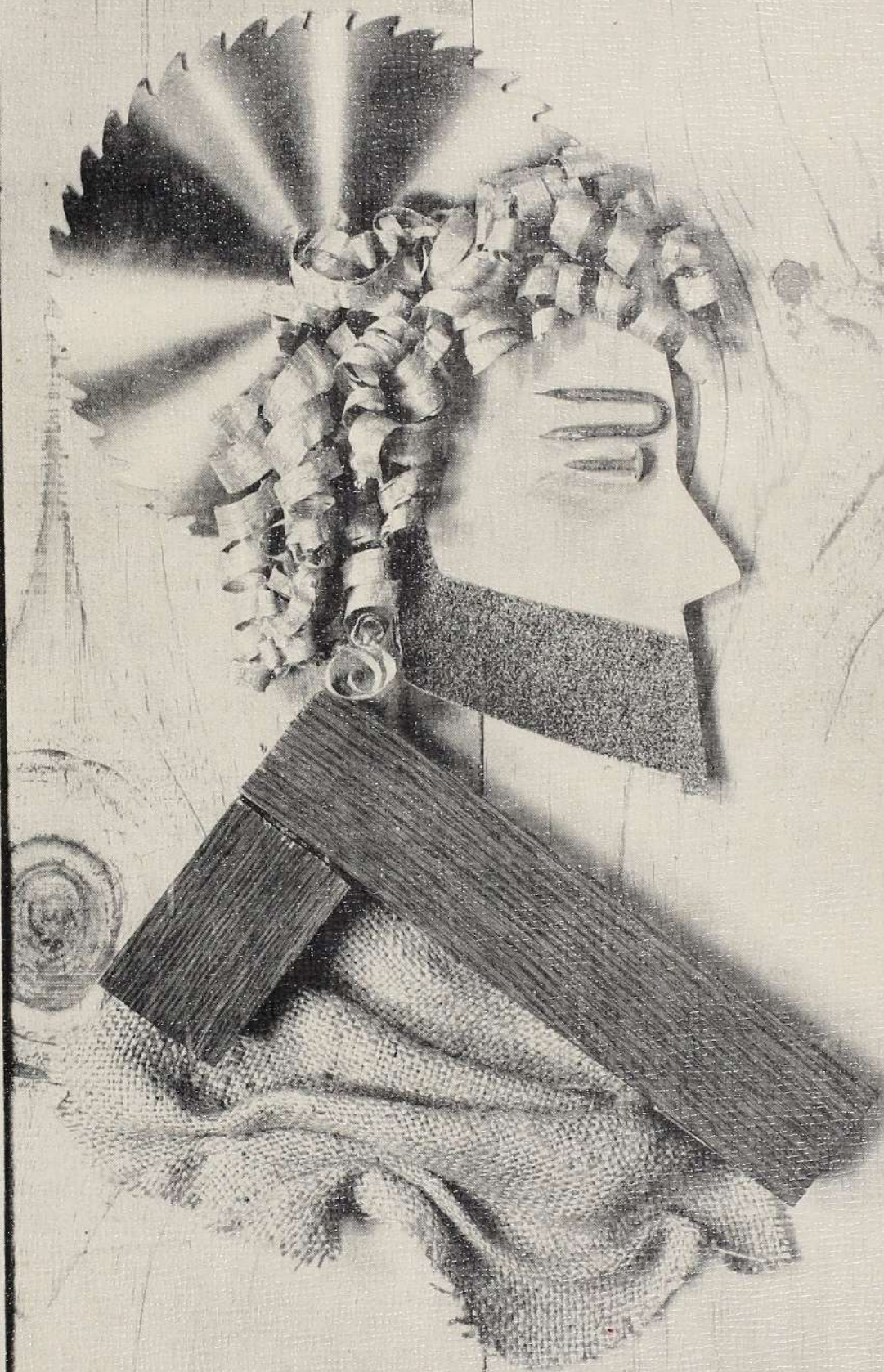
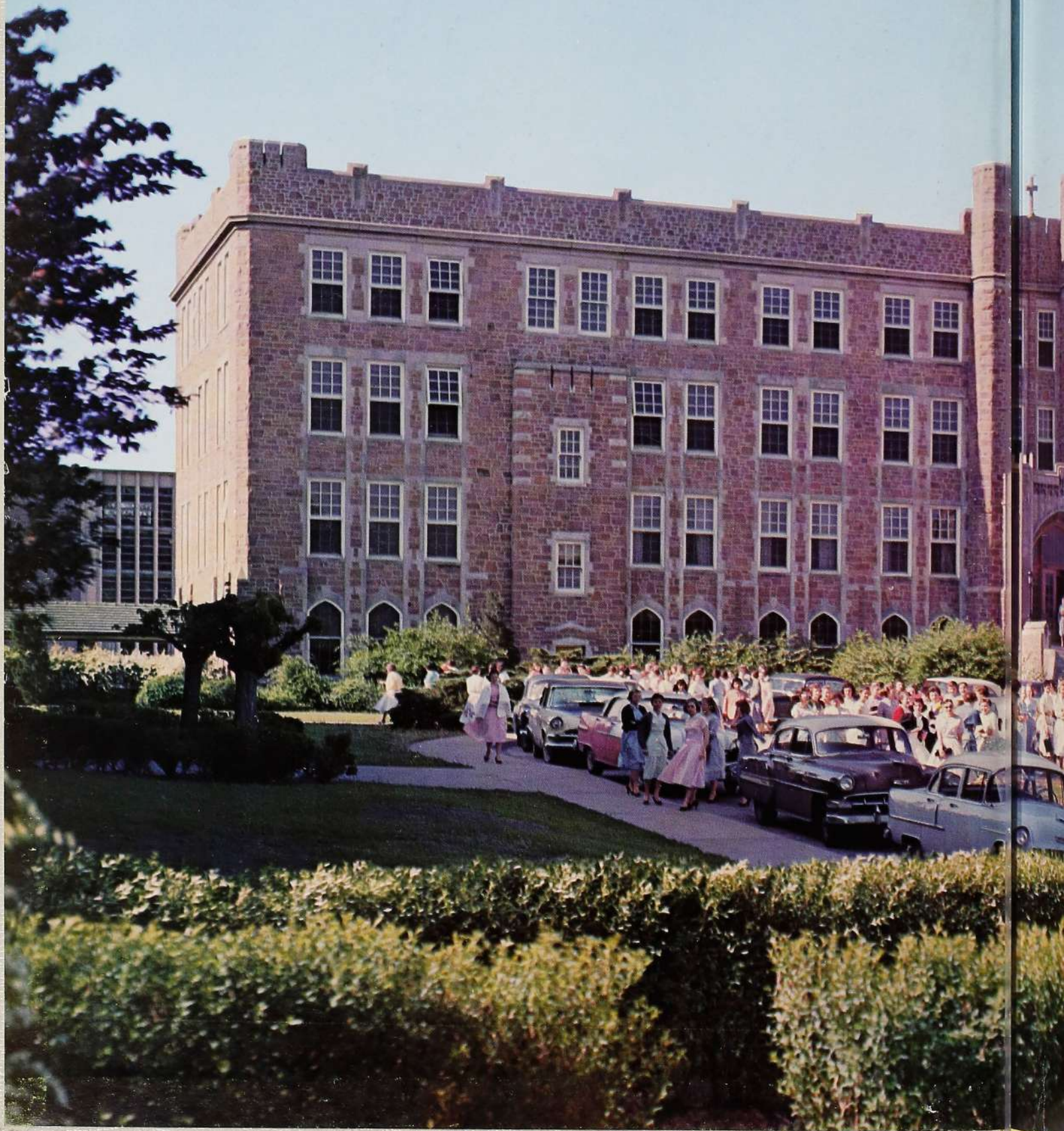

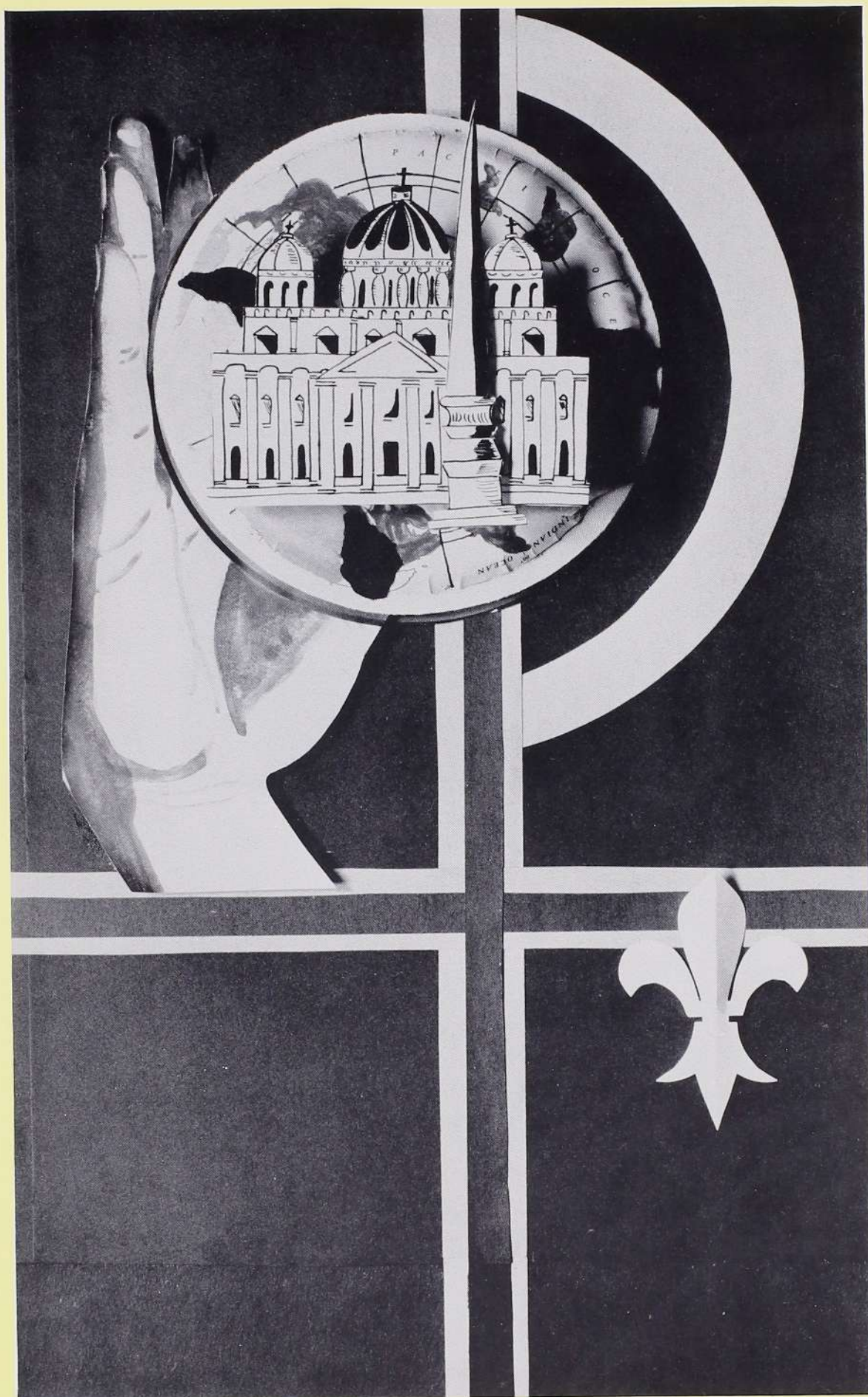


Saint Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church

For many years Saint Joseph has been invoked as Patron of the Catholic Church in the world. During his life he lived deep in the mystery of Jesus and Mary. After his death, now in Heaven, Saint Joseph still watches over the Church as he did its Divine Founder.

The design represents Saint Joseph's hand holding up St. Peter's, the principal Church of Christendom, surrounded by the map of the world. The stylized lily, the fleur-de-lis, symbolizes the purity of Saint Joseph's patronage. *The Chi Rho is Christ.*

Scripture relates that Saint Joseph was just, pure, gentle, prudent, and a lover of holy silence. Above all, this Carpenter of Nazareth was unfailingly obedient to the will of God. The love of Saint Joseph for Mary was strong and pure and faithful.

In the representation the two pillars and the straw roof signify the Stable in Bethlehem, over which is hanging the Star directing the reader to the Crib and to Saint Joseph. He is represented by the lily. The entwining rings symbolize the espousals of Saint Joseph and the Blessed Virgin Mary.

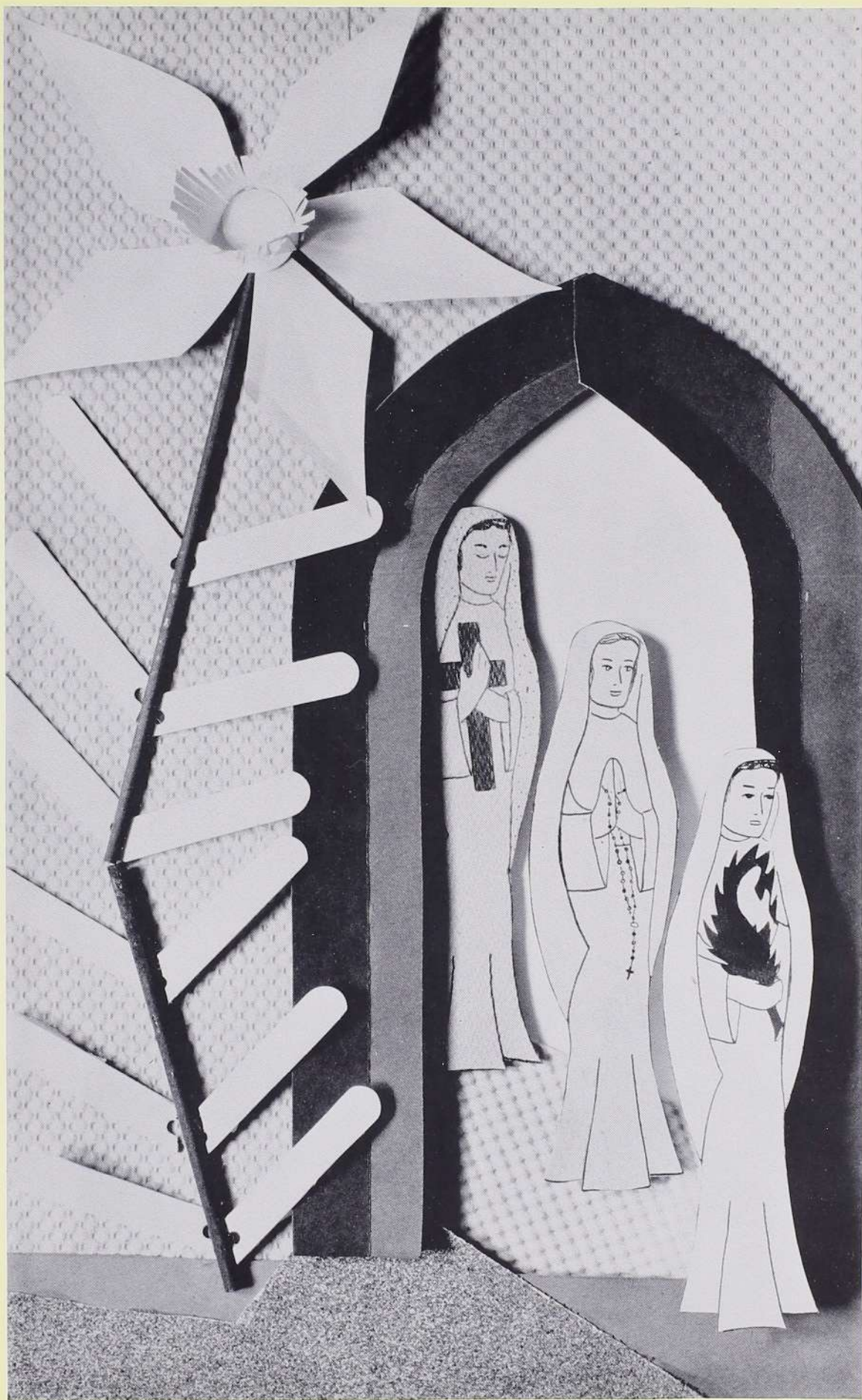

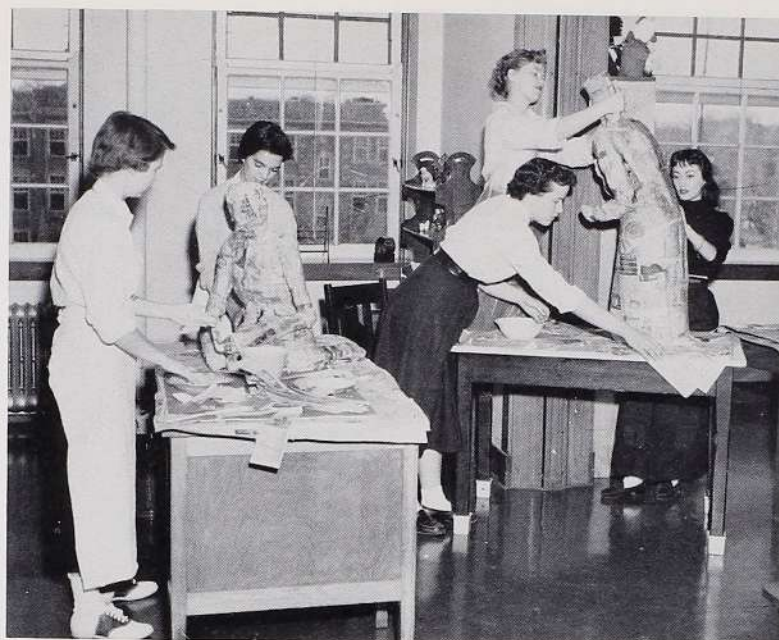

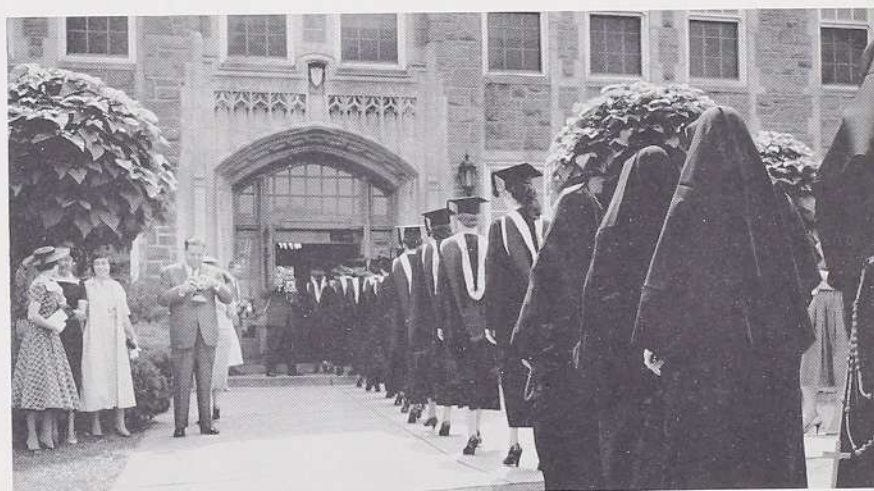
