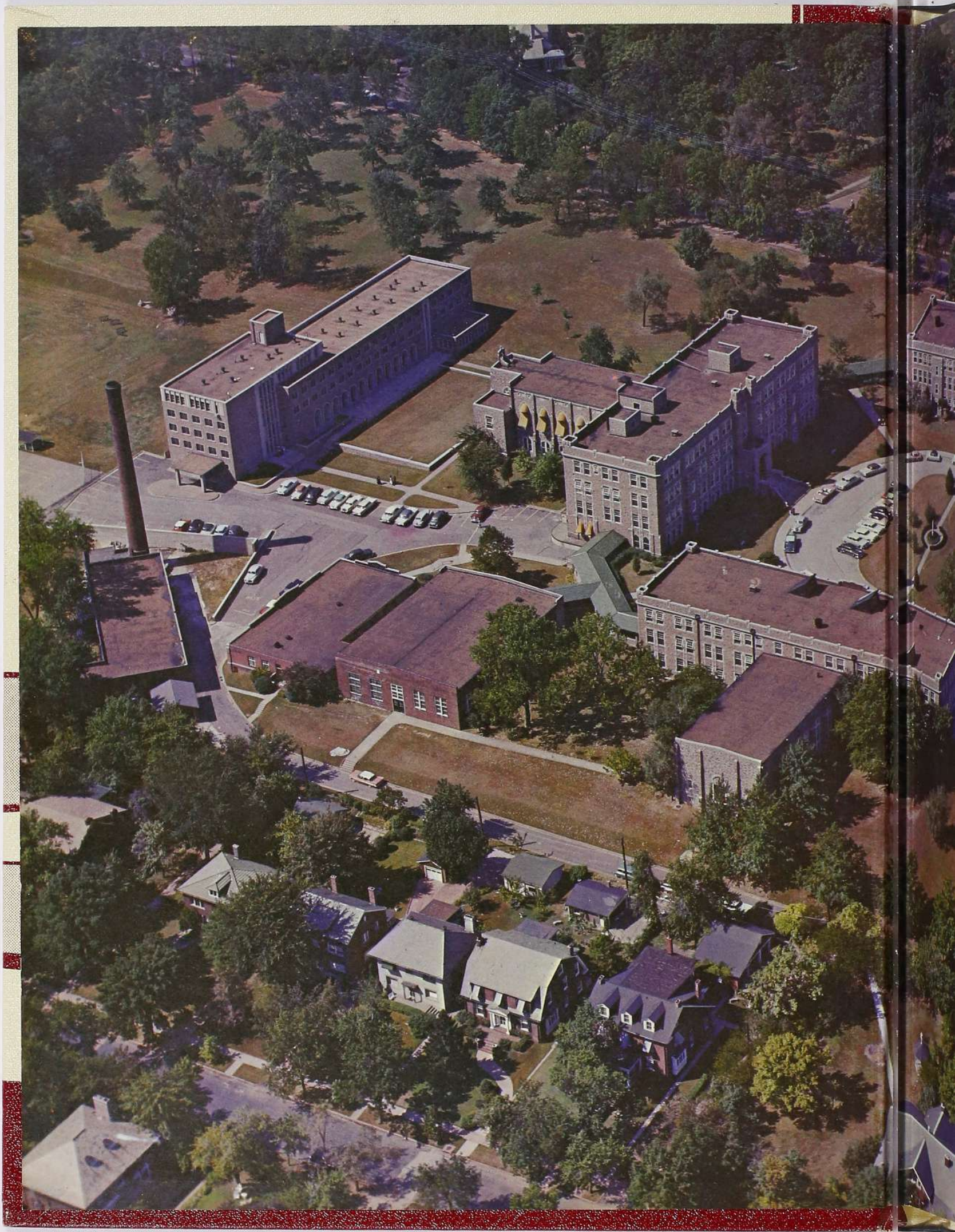
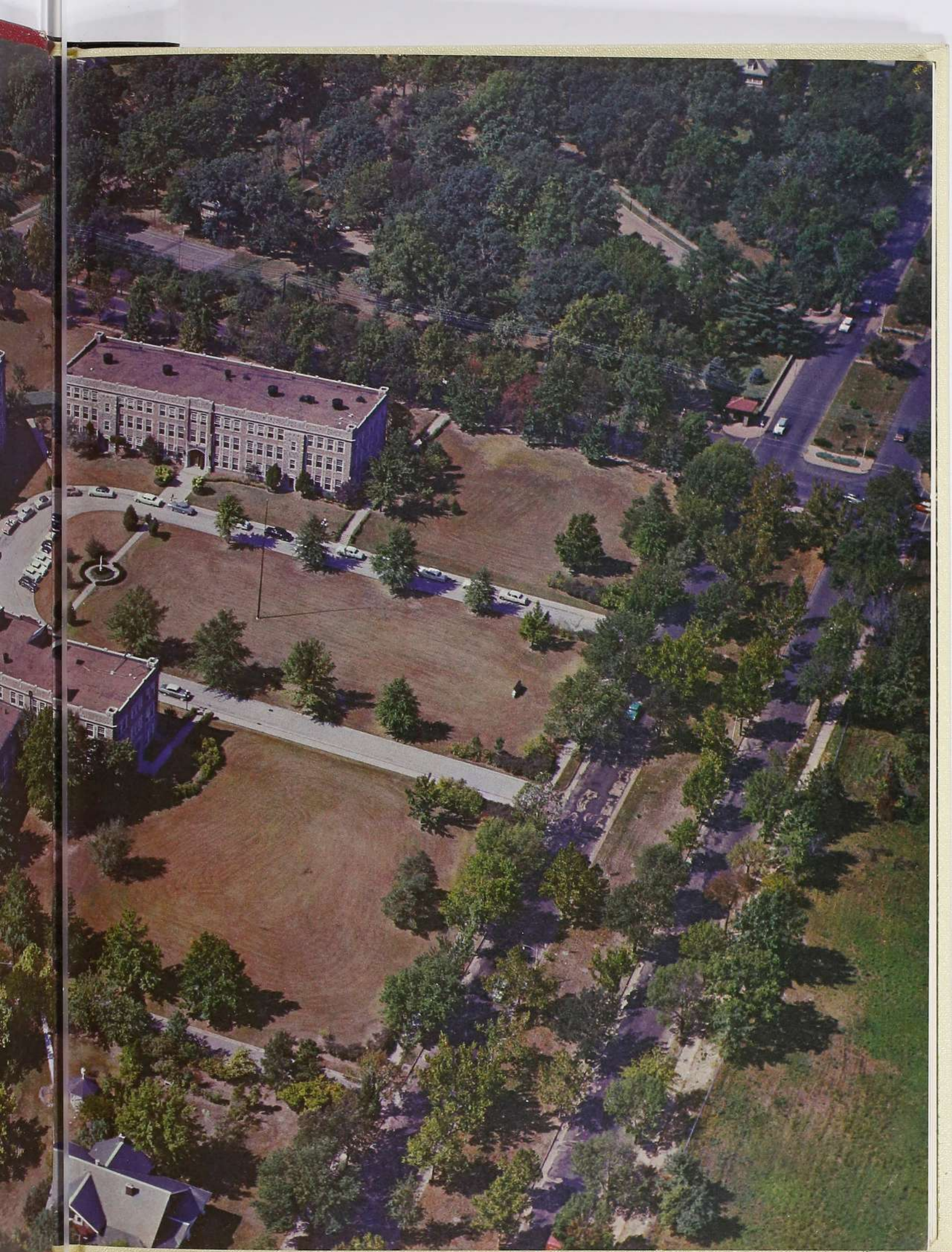

COVER DESIGN

The cover design of the 1959 *Fontbonne* features Saint Joseph's Chapel, Ryan Hall, Fontbonne, the focal point of the campus as well as the center of life of Fontbonne students.

In Saint Joseph's Chapel the celebration of Mass takes place every day; from the holy place flows the Source of all Grace, Christ the Great High Priest.

The four division pages represent the four principal parts of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass: The Mass of the Catechumens, the Offertory, the Consecration, and the Communion. Each symbol has a specific meaning with regard to the part of the Mass illustrated, and the lines and curves contribute to the general theme of each drawing.

The spirit of offering is conveyed by the many upward - swinging lines, by the upturned head of the girl, and by the raised hands of the priest. At the Offertory Catholics relinquish their selfish grip on themselves and on the world. They unite themselves to Christ, represented by the Christogram, and to the entire Mystical Body, represented by the globe, in the corporate act of surrender.

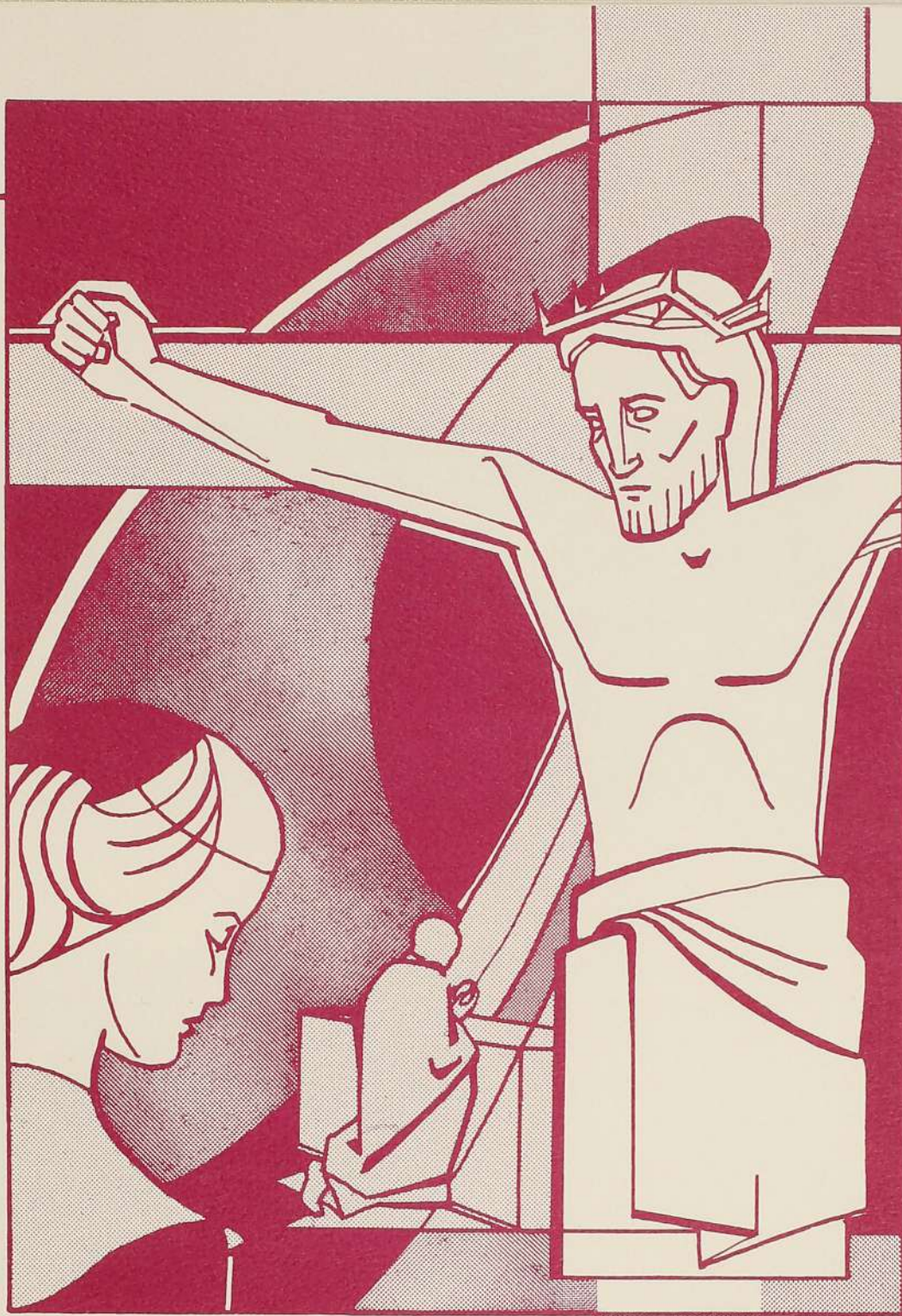

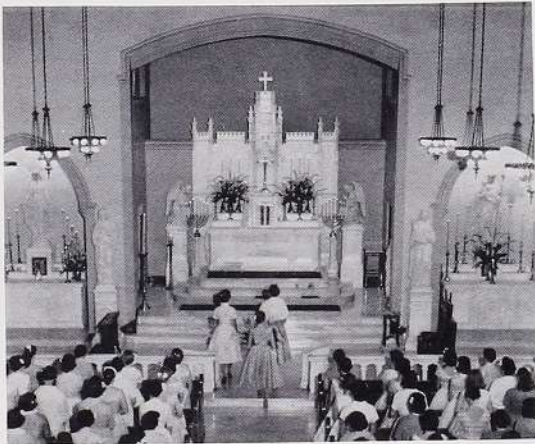

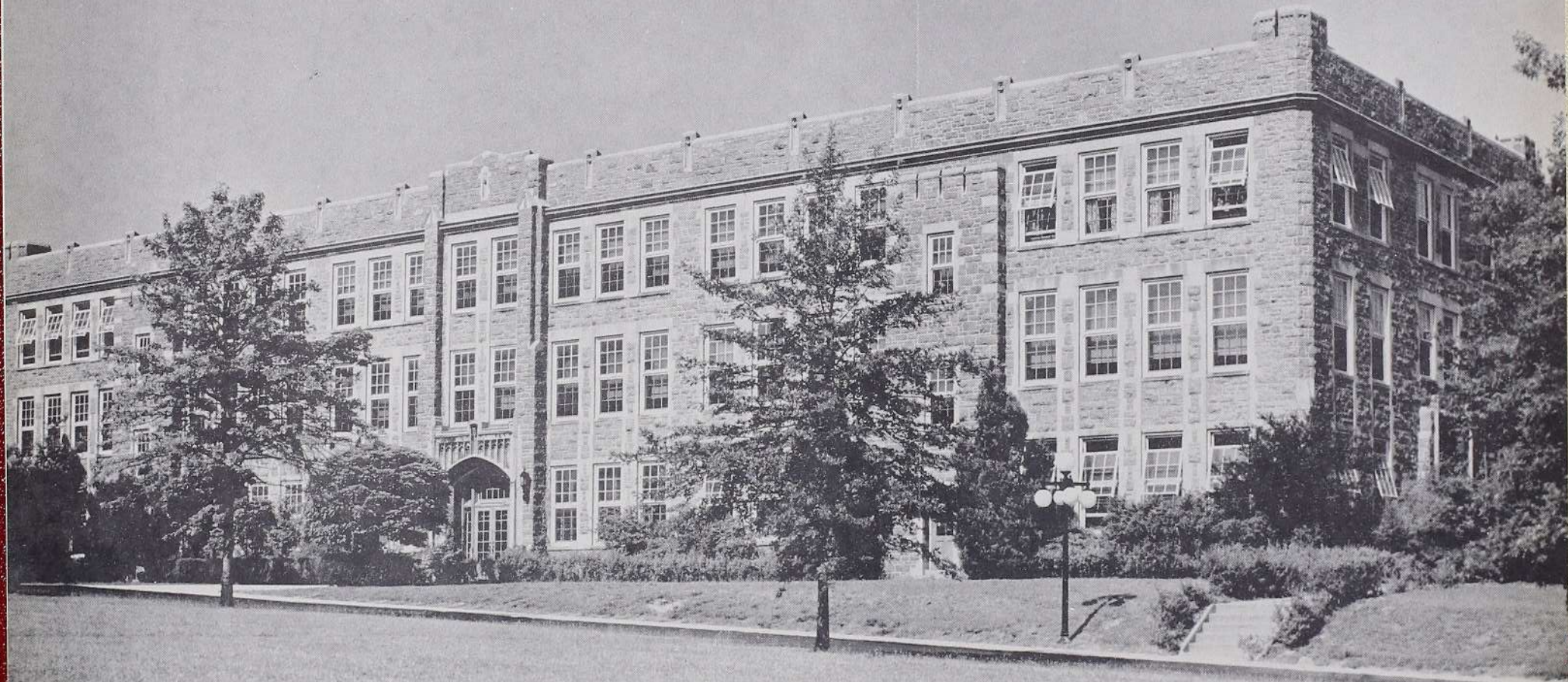

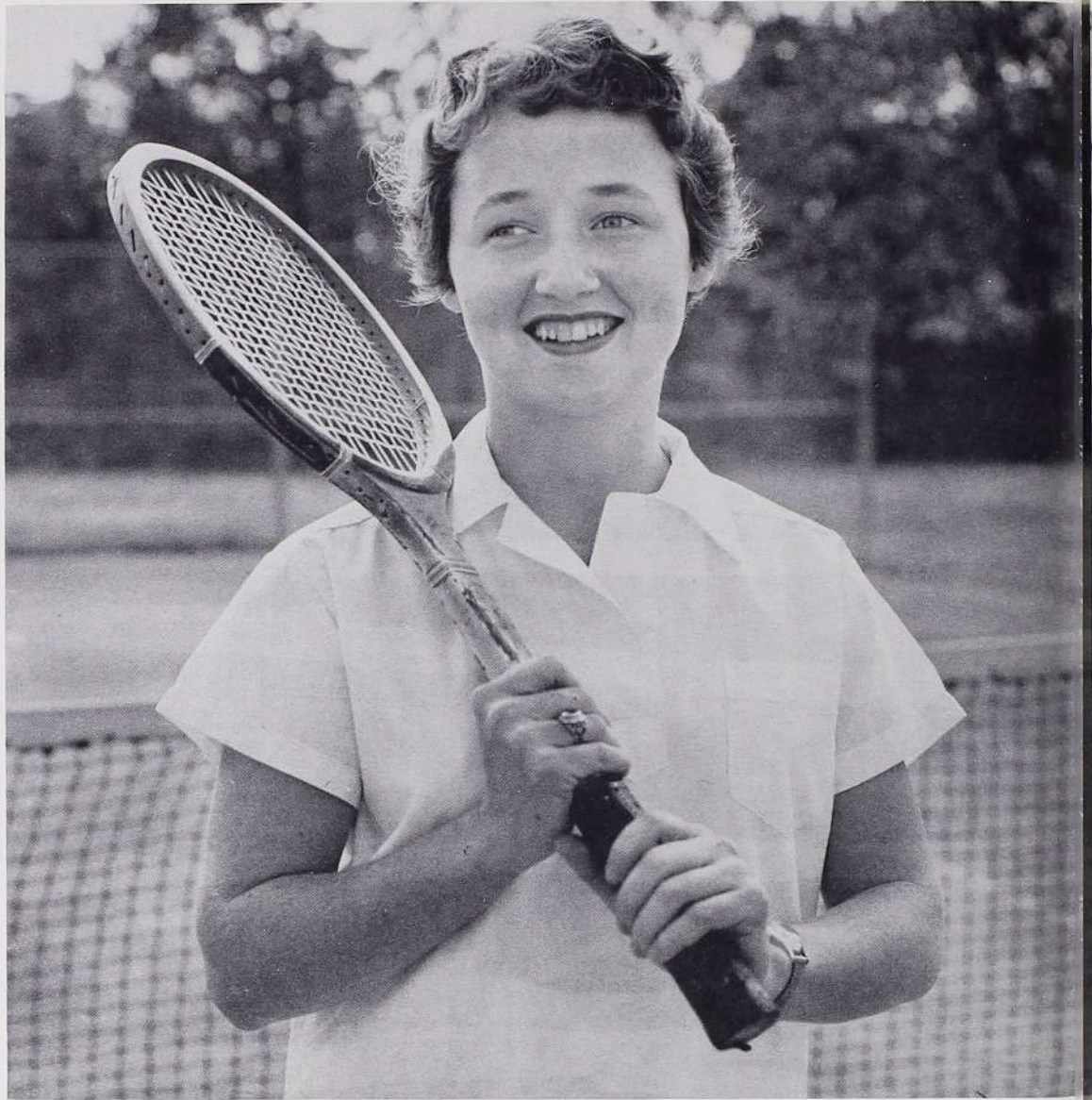
