The concert includes a performance of Albinoni's *Adagio in G minor*, a piece played by Vedran Smailović, "the Cellist of Sarajevo," at multiple sites of destruction during the siege of Sarajevo to honor those who lost their lives. Doors open at 6:30pm, and no tickets or reservations are required.
