Throughout this month, we'll be sharing tips to help keep your electronic devices and personal information safe and secure.


One way to protect yourself online is to ensure that you **enable automatic updates** on your electronic devices. Remember to do this on your computer, phone, and all electronic devices you use! Companies routinely issue updates that help to patch security vulnerabilities, so enabling automatic updates is an easy way to keep yourself safe. Are you wearing your mask properly?

Masks should be of a type and fit as recommended by the <u>CDC</u>. In particular, cloth masks should have two or more layers of fabric, **should completely cover your nose and mouth**, should fit snuggly against your face without gaps, and should not have exhalation valves, gaps, holes, or mesh that would allow virus particles to escape.
