Come visit campus.

Even if you've already been to campus, it never hurts to come back and take a second look. Picture yourself as part of Griffin Nation! Set up a tour with a student ambassador, request to sit in on a class or come up to campus for a game. Schedule a visit online at www.fontbonne.edu/visit.

Secure your spot in the Class of 2020.

Pay your enrollment deposit online at www.fontbonne.edu/enrolldep or mail it to: Office of Admission, 6800 Wydown Blvd. St. Louis, MO 63105. If you do not plan to live on campus, the deposit is \$100, which will be applied toward your student account once you register for classes. The deposit is \$300 if you plan to live in the residence halls. This deposit is refundable if requested by May 1 should your plans change.

Send updated ACT/SAT scores.

If you have retaken the ACT or SAT since being accepted, please send Fontbonne your updated scores. The last scores that will be accepted for review will be the December ACT and the January SAT.

Complete your FAFSA as soon as it becomes available.

Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov to complete the 2016-2017 FAFSA and be sure to add Fontbonne's school code (002464) to determine what other types of aid you may qualify for through the government and/or through Fontbonne.

Sign up for Griffin 101, Orientation & Registration.

Dates will be posted in early 2016 at www.fontbonne.edu/griffin101.

Submit any AP scores or college credit transcripts.

These should be sent directly from College Board (AP scores) or from the college from which you received credit.

Submit final transcripts.

After graduation, we will need a final transcript with your graduation date posted to finalize your file.
