### Admissions Requirements

A Bachelor's degree from an accredited, degree-granting college or university. Official transcripts must be received directly from the institution.

A completed application form and \$25 non-refundable application fee.

A minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Applicants whose native language is not English must pass the TOEFL with a score of 250 CBT/100 IBT or a Fontbonne authorized equivalent.

Student required to have three years of cumulative professional work experience to apply for program.

Business faculty admissions council will review all applications.

Two letters of recommendation that indicate the student's capacity to pursue graduate-level education.

### Requirements & Policies

Students are limited to only taking 6 credit hours outside of the weekend format.

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 is required for the program. A student receiving a grade less than B- in two or more courses or an F in one course in the curriculum may be dismissed from the program, notwithstanding a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

The maximum time for completion of the program is six years from the date of the beginning of the first course in the program.

### Admissions Requirements

4. Have been completed within the six years prior to entry.
