It is moved that:

A certificate in Case Management be created from foundation and professional practice social work courses.

Rationale

The Case Management Certificate offers students the advantage of an additional professional credential that supports employment and advanced graduate study opportunities. The certificate curriculum follows the National Association of Social Workers Standards for Social Work Case Management practice and prepares students to apply for NASW Certification. Social work administrators and professionals working in institutions providing case management services have been consulted and support the development of the certificate content area.

The social work curriculum includes required foundation and field courses and self-selected professional practice courses. The case management certificate offers students the opportunity to self-select professional practice courses specific to case management that meet the certification standards.
